FOOTBALL legend Gary Neville has lent his support to a Leigh pupil set to become the Children's Parliament's newly-elected Prime Minister.

In an event organised by the Sir David Amess Children's Parliament and international charity Football for Peace, Harry Acheampong, a student at Thorpe Hall School, will hand over the reins of power to 11-year-old Clark Dearson, representing Saint Pierre School in Leigh.

In a video congratulating Clark, Gary Neville said: "It's fantastic to see young people discussing the issues that matter to them."

The event, set to unfold in the heart of Westminster, is dedicated to raising awareness of global water scarcity issues, in a campaign project called 'Rehydrating the Earth'.

With Gary Neville's commendation underscoring the significance of the occasion, the event not only celebrates the remarkable achievements of these young leaders, but also highlights Leigh's contribution to nurturing the next generation of visionary changemakers.
