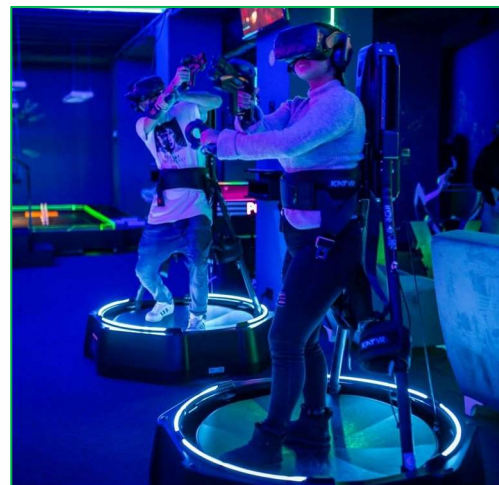


A note from the PTFA:
