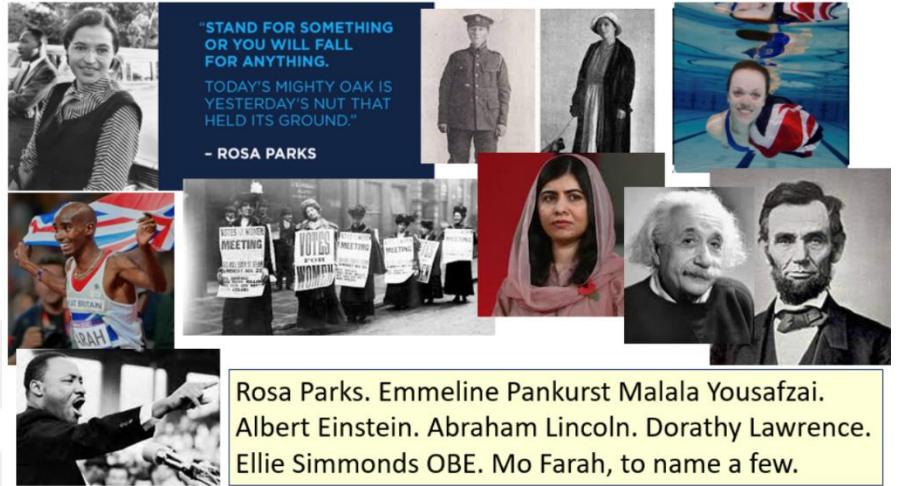




FLOURISH POSTERS

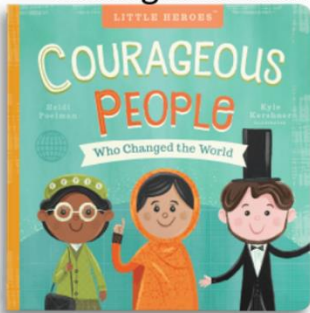
In Flourish lessons pupils have been reflecting on what courage means to them, what it feels like, and examples of when it could be experienced.
