- **CONGRATULATIONS** to our year 6 who worked very hard towards the 11 plus and received their results during half term. They achieved a 70% pass rate (a pass being achieving the 303 marks required for local grammar schools). Even those who didn't pass got excellent marks with two of them frustratingly scoring 302.7.
- **ANTI-BULLYING WEEK** - On Monday 13<sup>th</sup> November, to mark the start of Anti-bullying week and the 'odd socks' initiative, we ask that your child comes to school wearing different socks alongside their normal uniform. If your child is wearing tights they can wear these over the top of them. These socks can be any design but ideally shouldn't match. The socks represent their uniqueness and all of our differences.
